

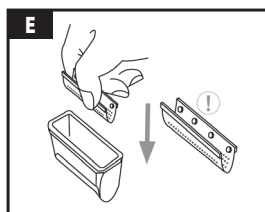

EXPLANATION OF SYMBOLS

WARNING!

UNPACKING AND INSPECTING THE PRODUCT

- DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN!
Packaging materials contain plastic ingredients that can cause suffocation.
- Remove packaging and ensure all accessories (fig. A) are included.
- Inspect the product and accessories for visible signs of damage.

GENERAL USE WARNINGS

- KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN: Intended for adult use only.
- Refer to product packaging or affixed data plate for technical specifications.
- Intended for use on human hair only.
Use with wigs, animal fur or any other material voids the manufacturer's warranty.
- It is normal for the device to get hot during use and while charging.
- Designed for use at temperatures between 41°F and 104°F.

- Do not insert any foreign objects into the device.
- Those with physical, sensory and/or mental disabilities should be cautioned of dangers before use.
- In the event of damage from a fall, significant impact or other malfunction contact customer service at (888) 864-6409.



CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Charge completely prior to first use and when the LED indicator is red.
- 2) Make sure the switch (3) is in the “OFF” position.
- 3) Connect the fast-charging adapter (8) to the wall's electrical socket and insert the USB charging cable (9).
- 4) Connect the USB cable (9) to the charging port (5).
- 5) When charging is complete the LED indicator will turn green.
- 6) Disconnect the charging cable (9) from the shaver when finished.

Note: This device can be operated cordless by battery power or while connected to the power supply.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- To avoid risk of injury, do not use if the foil head (1), head enclosure (2) or blades (6/7) are damaged.
- Avoid use on injured skin and imperfections such as bumps, blemishes, etc.
- Never use without the head enclosure (2) in place.
- Do not use on wet hair.
- Remove protective cap (11) and make sure the shaver is clean and dry before use.
- Turn on by moving the switch (3) up to the “ON” position.
- Gently stretch skin and shave against hair growth.
- When finished using, power off by moving the switch (3) down to the “OFF” position.
- Store in a cool, dry place after use.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

- To avoid injury, maintenance should only be performed by a skilled professional.
- Cleaning is recommended after each use.
- Always disconnect the power cord from electrical socket before cleaning.
- To avoid electric shock, do not immerse in water to clean.

- Exterior can be cleaned by wiping with a clean, soft, slightly damp cloth.
- Do not clean with abrasive solutions or concentrated detergents.
- Make sure all parts are completely dry before using.
- In case of malfunction or damage, do not attempt to disassemble and contact customer service at (888) 864-6409.

To clean blades and interior of the head enclosure (2), refer to figure B and the following instructions:

- 1) Take care not to drop while handling as the foil head and head enclosure are delicate and prone to damage.
- 2) Make sure the device is powered “OFF” and disconnected from power source before cleaning.
- 3) Lift the head enclosure with force to remove.
- 4) To remove the foil head, firmly grasp and pull up.
- 5) Clean by blowing on it gently or with soap and water.
- 6) Make sure foil is completely dry before inserting into the head enclosure.

For instructions on blade replacement refer to figure C and the following instructions:

- 1) Make sure the device is powered “OFF” and disconnected from power source before changing blades.

2) Remove foil head and head enclosure (refer to fig. B and cleaning instructions above for details).

3) Gently grasp the blade (6, 7) and pull up to release from the central pin support (12).

4) Grasp the new blade from both sides and insert it into the central pin (13).

5) Align with razor body and press firmly until blade snaps into place.

6) Replace foil head and head enclosure.

DISPOSAL

- Packaging is made from recycled materials.
- Separate parts according to type and dispose in accordance with applicable environmental protection regulations.
- Remove lithium battery prior to disposal.
- Do not dispose battery or power adapter with domestic waste; refer to important safety instructions above for proper handling.
- Batteries and power adapters are collected free of charge at local collection points (refer to your local council) or by any battery retailer.
- The end user is responsible for proper disposal at a special waste collection center.
- Do not reconnect the appliance to the power supply after the batteries have been removed.

A postage and handling charge of \$14.95 will apply. Please ensure proper packaging to prevent damage. We are not responsible for loss or damage during transit.
